AGREED ORDER RE: MOTION TO CORRECT ILLEGAL SENTENCE

THIS CAUSE, having come on to be heard before the Court on the Motion to Correct Illegal Sentence filed on August 16, 2021, and the Court after considering the Motion and being otherwise advised on the premises and with no objection from the State, it is hereby:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Defendant's Motion to Correct Sentence is granted and the Defendant's sentence is as follows:

- 1. On Count I, the Defendant is sentenced to life in prison.
- 2. On Count II, the Defendant is sentenced to life in prison, consecutive to Count I.
- 3. On Count III, the Defendant is sentenced to life in prison, consecutive to Count II.
- 4. On Count V, the Defendant is sentenced to life in prison, consecutive to Count III.
- 5. On Count VI, the Defendant is sentence to life in prison consecutive to Count V.
- 6. On Count VII, the Defendant's sentence shall be vacated and the State will announce a nolle prosequel.
- 7. On Count VIII, the Defendant is sentenced to fifteen years in state prison consecutive to Count VI.
- 8. On Count IX, the Defendant is sentenced to five years in state prison consecutive to Count VIII.

It is noted that the State is agreeing to vacate and *nolle prosequel* Count VII in the interest of judicial economy. The State does not concede the issues in the defense motion but will accede to the requested relief due to the multiple life sentences already imposed on the Defendant.
